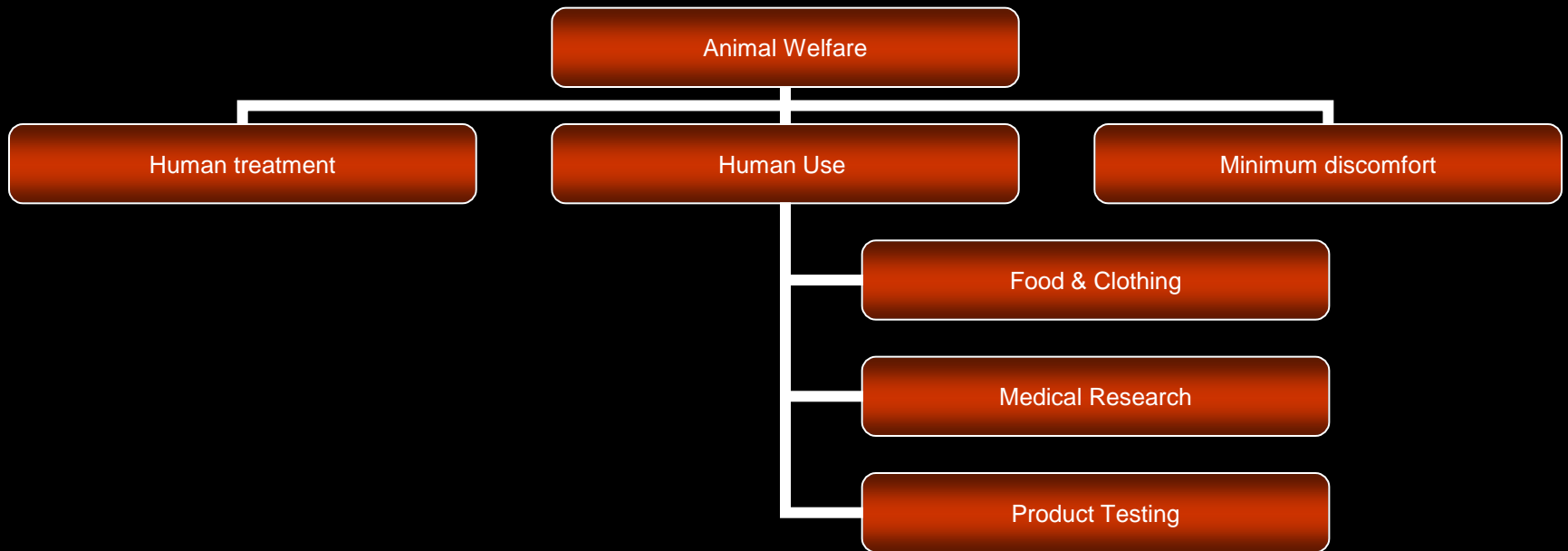

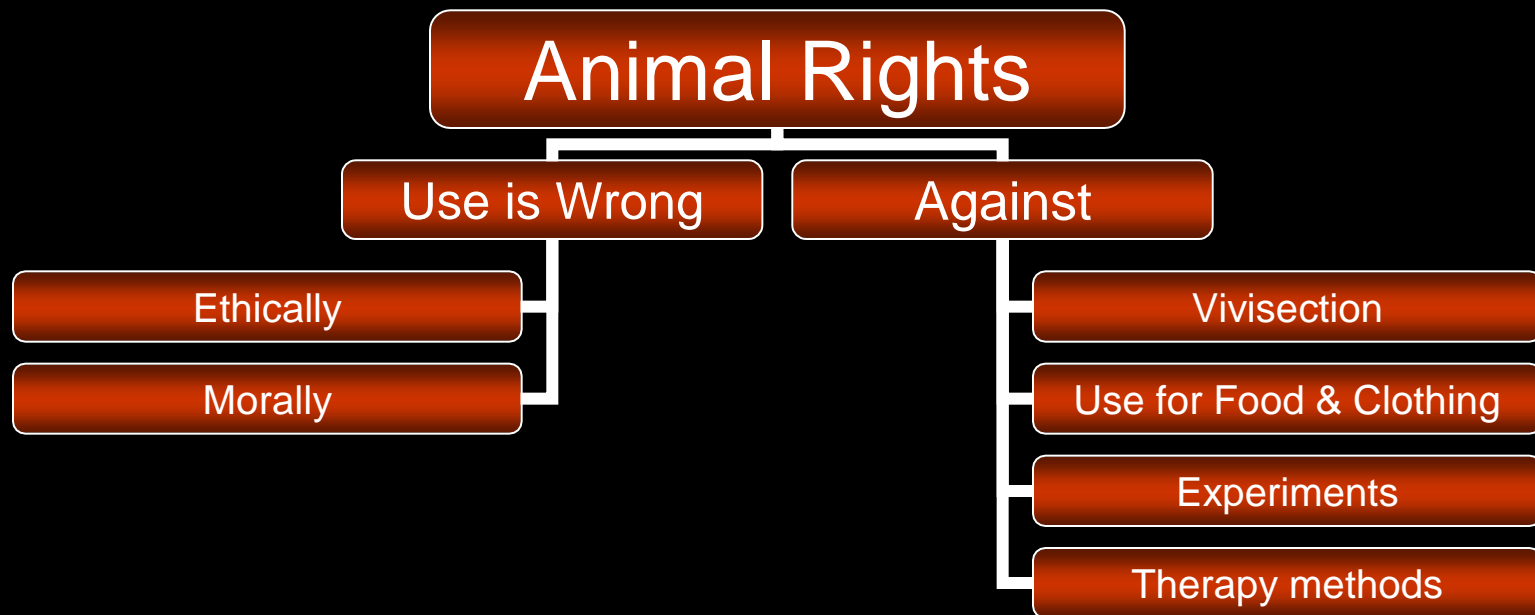

1. 1641 The Bodies of Liberty
 - 1st law to protect farm animals
2. 1st anticruelty act passed
 - 1828
 - New York Legislature
3. 1866- American Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals (ASPCA) formed

4. 1906- Animal Transportation Act
5. 1958- Humane Slaughter Act
6. 1966- Laboratory Animal Welfare Act
7. 1976- Horse Protection Act
